



AMERICA'S OLDEST

The Maryland Jockey Club's familiar monogram insignia is the oldest in racing. Stirrups and bit form the letter "M" and a jockey's whip forms the "J". The "C" in the familiar trademark takes shape of a spur. The insignia was used by the Maryland Jockey Club in daily programs as early as 1830.

PIMLICO PAULIE

Paul Nicol, Jr. set a Pimlico record by riding seven winners on June 8, 1983. The previous mark at Old Hilltop was six first place finishes by Chris McCarron in 1974, the year he rode 546 winners.

FIRST YEAR PHENOMS

Maryland-based riders have captured nine of the 38 Eclipse Awards for Outstanding Apprentice. Chris McCarron (1974), Ronnie Franklin (1978), Alberto Delgado (1982), Allen Stacy (1986), Kent Desormeaux (1987), Mike Luzzi (1989), Mark Johnston (1990), Jeremy Rose (2001) and Ryan Fogelsonger (2002) have brought home the hardware for the state.

LOVING LAUREL

Horacio Karamanos tied Chuck Baltazar's 33-year-old record by riding seven winners at Laurel Park on October 26, 2002. After finishing second in the first race of the day, Baltazar rode seven straight winners on December, 15, 1969. Bill Hartack won six races on November 5, 1955, while Kent Desormeaux had a pair of six-win days in February, 1989 (17 & 28), the year he won a record 598 races. Jockey Mario Pino was aboard six winners on October 25, 2003.
