Rules and Conditions

Tournament Summary

Dates: Saturdays beginning January 27th 2018 through March 3rd 2018 (Six Weeks)

Site: Laurel Park

Fees/Entries: \$10 per entry/max of 2 entries per week, per person

All participants must be members of the MJC Player Rewards Program.

Format: \$2 mythical Win/Place wagers on the final five live races at Laurel Park and two designated races from Gulfstream Park, for a total of seven races.

The top five finishers each week will be awarded points. Points are accumulated throughout the duration of the entire tournament. The top three finishers, in total accumulated points, will be eligible for prizes.

*Only one entry per person, per week, is eligible for points. If a player has two entries finish in the top five in the same week, the higher point value will be credited to that player. The entire allotment of 30 points will be distributed each week.

Prize Structure: \$10 per entry per week. The Maryland Jockey Club will match the weekly pot **up to <u>\$500</u>** per week.

Weekly Prize distribution

- 1st- 65% of entry fee plus MJC match
- 2nd- 25% of entry fee plus MJC match
- 3rd- 10% of entry fee plus MJC match

Weekly Point Allocation* (Points Accumulate all 6 weeks)

- 1st- 10 points
- 2nd- 8 points
- 3rd- 6 points
- 4th- 4 points
- 5th- 2 points

Prize for most accumulated points at the end of week 6

- 1st- \$1,000
- 2nd- \$500
- 3rd-\$250

Registration: Entry Forms will be at Guest Services counter at Laurel Park. Completed entry forms and full payment must be submitted at the Guest Services Counter prior to post time of the first contest race. Entries must be paid with Cash or player reward points.

Tie-Breakers: In the event of a tie, the participating members involved in the tie will split the corresponding prize money and weekly point allocation.

Late Scratch: If a player's Top Selection is a late scratch, the player's new top selection will be the post time favorite. If a players Top Selection is part of a coupled entry and the top selection scratches, the Top Selection would then be horse(s) remaining in the entry. Example: If a Participant's Top Selection is 1a and the 1a is a gate scratch, his new top selection would be the 1 if that horse is still entered to run.

Eligibility:

All contestants must be at least 18 years of age to participate. Employees of the Maryland Jockey Club or its affiliates that have access to the Tote room and can affect the outcome of a race are not eligible to participate.

General Terms and Conditions:
