Entry in the Champions tournament includes complimentary parking and admission, a multi-signal program, and lunch buffet. There are 4 berths available to choose: One of two berths into the NTRA/DRF National Handicapping Challenge, one berth into The Breeders' Cup Betting Challenge or one berth into The Big One. The first place finisher can choose 1 of any of the 4 berths. The second place finisher has a choice of 1 of the 3 remaining berths. The third place finisher has a choice of 1 of the 2 remaining berths and the fourth place finisher wins the remaining berth.

To be eligible for NHC seats, Players MUST be an NTRA Tour Member PRIOR to the start of the Champions Tournament. If a player is ineligible, the NHC berth will be awarded to the entrant with the next highest tournament bankroll.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- 1. The Maryland Jockey Club "Champions" Tournament is a single day competition on Saturday, August 20, 2016 in the Carriage Room at Laurel Park.
- 2. Two entries maximum per person are allowed.
- 3. The competition is limited to the first 300 Entries.
- 4. Players must be at least 21 years of age to participate in the Champions Tournament.
- 5. A \$100 non-refundable entry fee/per entry is required at the time of registration.
- 6. Entrants may pay the entry fee with cash, credit card, traveler's check, money order, or cashier's check. **No personal checks are accepted.**
- 7. Premier Player Club members may use a \$100 redemption voucher for the entry fee(s).
- 8. Mail in registrations will be accepted if they are received, on or before, Wednesday, August 17, 2016. Make money orders or cashier's checks payable to The Maryland Jockey Club and mail to:

Registrations by phone or in-person will be accepted from Friday, July 22, until NOON on Friday, August 19, 2016.

- 9. Registration forms must be accompanied by a \$100 money order, cashier's check or credit card information.
- 10. Entrants will be required to stake a **\$200 account bankroll** to make **Win, Place** and **Show** wagers on designated tracks available for pari-mutuel wagering at Laurel Park on Saturday, August 20, 2016 for each entry. It is recommended, but not required, that the \$200 account bankroll be submitted with the registration form. The account bankroll may not be placed on credit card; the bankroll **must** be money order, cashiers check, or cash.
- 11. Check-in for all Entrants begins at 10:00am on Saturday, August 20, 2016. The Carriage Room is located adjacent to the Laurel Park Grandstand. Directional signage leads to the designated parking area, and entrance for the Carriage Room.
- 12. Rules orientation and a review will occur about at 12:20 p.m. All entrants must be present for the orientation or sign a waiver.
- 13. Entrants will use their **\$200 account bankroll** to place wagers on any race from the pool of races offered by the race tracks which have been designated for tournament purposes. The results are tabulated by a totalisator "account wagering" system, and are part of the actual wagering pool. Entrants cannot add additional cash to their bankroll.
- 14. Entrants must place a minimum of 10 wagers. No maximum.
- There is a \$20 minimum per wager. No maximum.

Regardless of the number of wagers made during the Tournament, the minimum per wager remains \$20. Only Win, Place and Show wagers are considered valid for the Tournament. Please note that wagers in denominations of repetitive double digits cannot be accepted. (i.e. \$22, \$33, \$44)

- 15. Entrants may make multiple wagers within any race available for tournament wagering.
- 16. **Multiple wagers within the same race are defined as:** a different bet on the same runner, i.e. wagers of \$20 to Win and \$20 to Place on any given runner; **or** the same bet on different runners, i.e. \$20 to Win on one runner and \$20 to Win on a different runner.
- 17. Only wagers on the following tracks are valid for the Tournament: Laurel, Saratoga, Monmouth, Gulfstream and Woodbine. All tournament wagers must be placed at specifically designated tournament teller windows.
- 18. Each Entrant will receive a printed receipt of their wager(s) from the specifically designated contest tellers after each wager is recorded. Entrants are responsible for verifying each wager at the time it is placed. DO NOT walk away from the window without verifying your wager.
- 19. Players must place all wagers personally. No person shall directly or indirectly act as an intermediary, transmitter or agent in placing wagers for the Player, unless authorized by the Maryland Jockey Club and for good reason shown.
- 20. The Maryland Jockey Club is not responsible if an Entrant is shut out of any race. All bets must be placed early enough to prevent the possibility of being shut out.
- 21. The Maryland Jockey Club and its vendors are not responsible for any incomplete transactions No Exceptions.
- 22. No cancellations on any wagers for any reason. All wagers are final.
- 23. Track rulings are official in the event of scratches or disqualifications.
- 24. If a scratch occurs after an Entrant places a wager, the money will be refunded to the Entrant's bankroll. All other tournament rules must remain in effect.

- 25. **Tournament wagering will begin at approximately 12:20 a.m and end after the last race from the available tracks.** Subject to change depending on post times for the valid tracks. Entrants' bankrolls will be tabulated at the close of tournament wagering. Prizes will be awarded to the Entrants' who accumulate the largest tournament "account bankrolls."
- 26. First place Entrant with the greatest pari-mutuel winnings at the end of the competition at Laurel Park on Saturday, August 20, will choose one entry into the 2016 Breeders' Cup Betting Challenge, the 2017 NHC or the 2016 The Big One.
- 27. Second place Entrant with the second greatest pari-mutuel winnings at the end of the competition at Laurel Park on Saturday, August 20, will choose one berth from the 3 remaining berths after the first place finisher has made his/her choice.
- 28. Third place Entrant with the third greatest pari-mutuel winnings at the end of the competition at Laurel Park on Saturday, August 20, will choose one berth from the 2 remaining berths after the first and second place finishers have made his/her choice.
- 29. Fourth place Entrant with the fourth greatest pari-mutuel winnings at the end of the competition at Laurel Park on Saturday, August 20, will receive the last berth remaining after the first, second and third place finishers have made his/her choice.
- 30. Guaranteed prize monies are based on 150 entries or less, and will be awarded as follows: First Place: \$1,500, Second Place: \$1,000, Third Place: \$500, Fourth Tenth Places: \$300.
- 31. Tournament entry fees remitted for the 151st entrant, and beyond, will be added to the Prize Schedule for 1st place through 10th place prize winners to share.
- 32. In the event of a tie between prize winners, the account with the most correct Win bets will be declared the winner of the tiebreaker. If a tie continues to exist, the account with the highest payout on a \$20 win wager will be declared the winner of the tiebreaker. If a tie continues to exist, the account with the most correct Place bets will be declared the winner of the tie-breaker. If a tie continues to exist, the account with the highest payout on a \$20 place wager will be declared the winner of the tiebreaker. If a tie continues to exist, the account with the most correct Show bets will be declared the winner of the tiebreaker. If a tie continues to exist, the account with the most correct Show bets will be declared the winner of the tie-breaker. If a tie continues to exist, the account with the highest payout on a \$20 show wager will be declared the winner of the tie-breaker. If a tie continues to exist, the account with the highest payout on a \$20 show wager will be declared the winner of the tie-breaker. - 33. All play is audited to verify the winner, immediately following the tournament. Prizes will be awarded only after official verification and final Maryland Jockey Club Mutuel Department audit.
- 34. All prizes are non-transferable with the exception of the Breeders' Cup Betting Challenge berth.
- 35. The Maryland Jockey Club reserves the right at any time to amend, to add, to delete, or to change any portion of the rules and regulations.
- 36. Winners are responsible for all applicable taxes.
- 37. All entrants, who are licensed in any way affiliated to horse racing, either by a state or by a race track, shall identify themselves to tournament officials prior to the tournament and identify any potential interest they have in any races eligible for wagering in this tournament. These licensees include, but are not limited to owners, trainers, track officials, jockey agents, and all licensed track employees. These entrants are ineligible to wager, for tournament purposes, on any race in which they have a horse competing and/or any other interest. Failure to abide by this rule may result in disqualification from this tournament.
- 38. Employees of the Maryland Jockey Club, Xpressbet, The Stronach Group and AmTote International, or any of their affiliated companies are not eligible to participate in the tournament.
- 39. Eligibility (e.g., employment or affiliation, family relationship, past winnings) may vary between the qualifying tournaments, however, eligibility rules for the finalists in the The Big One shall be established by the HorseTourneys.com's The Big One officials, eligibility rules for the finalists in the Breeders' Cup Betting Challenge shall be established by the Breeders' Cup Betting Challenge officials and eligibility rules for the finalists in the National Handicapping Championship shall be established by NHC officials.
- 40. The top 10 Champions finishers must communicate any request or changes in circumstance in writing to The Maryland Jockey Club.

The Breeders' Cup Betting Challenge Berth earned in this tournament or any non-online tournament during 2016 may be transferred to another horse player. In addition, there is no cash option. The qualifier or transferee must be in attendance at the The BCBC, the NHC and The Big One on each day of the respective event. Should any person qualifying for the any of the winning berths be unable to travel and represent the Maryland Jockey Club on the required tournament dates, that portion of the prize will be awarded to the Entrant with the next highest tournament "account bankroll." The NHC will take place in January 2017 in Las Vegas. The BCBC will take place on November 4 and 5, 2016 at Santa Anita Park in Arcadia, CA. The Big One will take place on September 24 & 25, 2016 at Laurel Park in Laurel, Maryland.
