SHIPPING IN. NEEDING CURRENT COGGINS. EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY: All horses shipping into and or running at Laurel Park or Pimlico MUST HAVE current coggins paperwork to be allowed on the property. Blood Drawn Slips WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Please make sure your Flu/Rhino Vaccinations up to date.

NO cars or trucks should be driving on the horse paths and leaving tire marks. All trainers must make sure the area around their barns are cleaned up. Security is going to start issuing fines if the areas are not cleaned up. Manure/Straw Bins need to be cleaned and covered. Nozzles need to be on hoses. This is your home, please help us keep it clean.
