Please make sure all doors to bathrooms, boiler rooms or any rooms that water lines are in are closed.

ATTENTION HORSEMEN: The use of rubber bands on any part of a horse's body during training or racing at an MJC facility is prohibited. Rubber bands may be used for braiding manes or tails.
