All trainers are required to put up "In Today" sign on the stalls of horses that are running. If an "In Today" sign is not on the stall it could result in a scratch.

IT IS THE TRAINERS RESPONSIBILITY TO HAVE THE COGGINS OF THEIR HORSES UP TO DATE. PLEASE BE RESPONSIBLE AND TAKE CARE OF YOUR BUSINESS.

HORSES NEED TO BE TATTOOED EVEN IF MICROCHIPPED. NO TATTOO WILL RESULT IN A SCRATCH.

Horses must have NAMES in order to break from the STARTING GATE in the mornings.

"When the emergency lights are on NO HORSES are allowed to come onto the track. Not following this rule will lead to a fine."

Any horses shipping into a barn other than the receiving barn needs to notify stall manager Terry Overmier 443-324-6646 and Lasix Coordinator Melanie Martin 443-631-4891. Failure to do so can result in a scratch.

Horses are not allowed to work within 48 hours of being scratched for medical reasons.

Starting January 1, 2020 any maiden that is six (6) years old or older are no longer eligible to run and must be taken off the backside immediately.
