

All trainers are required to put up "In Today" sign on the stalls of horses that are running. If an "In Today" sign is not on the stall it could result in a scratch.

IT IS THE TRAINERS RESPONSIBILITY TO HAVE THE COGGINS OF THEIR HORSES UP TO DATE. PLEASE BE RESPONSIBLE AND TAKE CARE OF YOUR BUSINESS.

Starting on June 1st any horse that has not finished 1st-4th in their last eight (8) starts will not be allowed on the grounds and entries will not be accepted.

HORSES NEED TO BE TATTOOED EVEN IF MICROCHIPPED. NO TATTOO WILL RESULT IN A SCRATCH.

Horses must have NAMES in order to break from the STARTING GATE in the mornings.

There will be turf works starting this Sunday at Laurel Park. There will be a \$150 fee that must be paid before horse works on the turf. Please check with racing office for more details and to sign up.

"When the emergency lights are on NO HORSES are allowed to come onto the track. Not following this rule will lead to a fine."

Please have your entries in by Noon on entry days.
