DANCING HOUSE hopped at the break then bobbed, regrouped and moved up outside HOT CITY GIRL nearing the five eighths pole, hounded that one around the turn, was caught between runners vying into the stretch, responded after being headed by LADY SABELIA in mid stretch, forged clear under aggressive hand encouragement near the sixteenth marker then held firm. CLOTHES FALL OFF rated between rivals early, angled in and edged closer leaving the three eighths, shifted out four wide for a clear run in upper stretch, straightened away and closed willingly to gain the place. LADY SABELIA rated back off of rivals soon after the break, steadily advanced between runners nearing the turn, angled four wide and lodged a bid to make it three abreast into the lane, dueled then poked a head in front of the winner in mid stretch, drifted in briefly then weakened through the final sixty yards. SWEET ON SMOKEY settled off the pace while saving ground, worked way out to the center of the track leaving mid stretch and finished with interest. WONDER GAL, four wide stalking the pace, was under pressure nearing the quarter pole and came up empty. HOT CITY GIRL cleared leaving the chute and secured the inside, was confronted by the winner near the five eighths, maintained the lead under coaxing around the turn, could not withstand the pressure of two rivals to her outside entering the lane and weakened a furlong from the wire. PRINCESS VIOLET eased back between runners leaving the five eighths, took the overland route around the turn and gave way.
