SEEKING TREASURE, taken to rate in mid pack, edged up into the far turn, dropped to the rail soon after, eased back out and moved up behind rivals leaving the three sixteenths, was stalled in mid stretch, quickened readily when a seam opened between rivals nearing the sixteenth marker, shifted in to take command and held firm under a drive. GINGER N RYE was steadied when put in tight quarters along the rail soon after the start, angled out and settled, crept closer three wide between foes mid way on the final turn, angled out to come four to five wide for the drive, lugged in slightly when engaging the leaders with a sixteenth to go and kept on gamely. NISHARORA (IRE) saved ground off the early pace, came under pressure leaving the far turn, moved up into the lane, angled out then was steadied when blocked from the eighth pole to about the sixteenth marker, altered out and finished well. ALL IN FUN settled well off the rail, commenced a run past the five sixteenths, circled five wide into the lane, moved out a bit wider progressing past the eighth pole then flattened out in the final yards. BRIDE TO BE, washy heading towards the gate, broke through prior, reloaded after a delay due to an injury to one of the assistant starters, rated off the pace three to four wide, took closer order nearing the quarter pole, moved to slim lead while dueling past the furlong grounds, brushed with NAKUTI (IRE) approaching the sixteenth pole then gave way grudgingly. NAKUTI (IRE) rated forwardly into the backstretch, moved up saving ground past the half mile marker, eased out into the far turn, took aim after six furlongs, bid between rivals soon into the lane, dueled past the eighth pole, drifted out slightly which allowed the winner room, straightened to keep on to deep stretch then faded. SILVERVILLE, unhurried while saving some ground, continued inside while trailing into the lane, angled out and had belated action. GYPSY JUDY slipped through inside rivals nearing the first turn and opened up when a bit headstrong, set a solid pace towards the rail, met bids entering the lane, kept on past the eighth pole then steadied when beginning to retreat a sixteenth out. HOPE CROSS (IRE), away alertly, was content to be rated off the leader into the first turn, stalked two to three wide, steadied when in a bit close nearing the quarter pole, remained in some traffic in upper stretch then gave way.
