SONNY INSPIRED edged up four wide nearing the half mile marker and gained a stalking position, took closer order under a light hold circling into the lane, forged to command leaving the three sixteenths, shook clear of a pair of rivals to his inside past the furlong grounds, wandered outward a bit, was corrected with right handed rousing and held firm. MAJESTIC HUSSAR broke a step slow, quickly recovered and tugged his way forward inside rivals, had to steady briefly near the half mile marker, checked off the heels of JAKE N ELWOOD when keen to go on soon into the lane, was maneuvered to about the five path leaving the three sixteenths and came back gamely. BEACH HUT prompted the pace three wide, bid between rivals in upper stretch, vied past the eighth pole then gave way grudgingly. FINAL PROSPECT broke slowly, settled back off the early pace, moved up some leaving the far turn and angled four wide, altered in leaving the eighth pole and kept on with interest. JAKE N ELWOOD was hustled clear early, set the pace two wide under some coaxing, dropped to the fence once engaged in upper stretch, battled on past the eighth pole then gave way the final sixteenth. MAXWELL SMARTY stalked the early pace off the rail, lightly steadied leaving the far turn, angled out and came up empty.
