NEVER GONE SOUTH was sent from the gate to establish command, rated kindly two wide dictating the pace, displayed a sharp burst when put to a solid hand ride three sixteenths from the wire, opened up a commanding lead while remaining under hand urging to the sixteenth pole then was geared down the final seventy yards. MARENGO ROAD leaned in soon after the break, straightened and prompted the winner three wide, came under pressure leaving the five sixteenths, proved no match from the head of the lane but did continue on willingly to hold down the place. HENRY THE KING broke a step slow then checked off the heels of HUNTIN'THEHOLIDAY after that one was forced inward by MARENGO ROAD leaving the chute, regrouped to settle off the pace, gathered momentum under urging mid turn, edged up between rivals in upper stretch, altered in and continued with interest. MOON OVER A BEAUTY stumbled at the break, recovered and was nudged forward four wide to gain a stalking position, was put to the whip pursuing past the quarter pole, stayed on willingly to mid stretch then faded. HUNTIN'THEHOLIDAYS, forced inward leaving the chute, corrected and tracked towards the rail, came under a ride past the five sixteenths, gave way and altered out in the drive.
