ABIDING STAR tugged his way clear three wide leaving the seven eighths pole, angled in and set a rated pace, came slightly off the rail leaving the far turn, maintained course as his rider kept a firm left hand grip past the five sixteenths, drifted three wide when let out a bit entering the lane, corrected and opened up when put to strong right handed rousing, switched to his left lead nearing the sixteenth pole but held firm. FLASH MCCAUL secured the rail early on, edged up a bit nearing the half mile marker, came under a ride soon after, hugged the rail progressing under a drive into the lane and kept on gamely to closed the gap. WHISKEY TREE came away in good order, rated back off the winner near the seven furlong marker, prompted the pace two wide, took closer measure leaving the far turn, could not quicken when asked mid way on the final turn, pursued to mid stretch then went even from there. MARENGO ROAD was taken off the inside and traveled three wide into the backstretch, remained in that path stalking inside a rival to the far turn, lacked a response when put to a ride soon after and gradually gave way through the drive. CHARMED VICTORY, taken off the early pace, made a slight move nearing the half mile pole, angled five wide giving hard pursuit into the lane, altered back in for the final furlong and retreated. LET ME GO FIRST lost ground four wide stalking the pace, failed to go on leaving the far turn and faltered.
