ADMIRALS WAR CHEST established command at once, set the pace off the rail while handling some inside pressure, moved away when given his cue leaving the far turn, widened the advantage into the lane, kept on under repeated right handed rousing and just lasted. BULLHEADED BOY settled well off the early pace, responded when put to a ride leaving the far turn, angled out advancing past the five sixteenths, worked between rivals into the lane, had his rider lose the whip soon past the three sixteenths and finished up nicely to just miss. I'M MR. BLUE got out a bit after steadying off heels the first turn and bumped with NOT ABROAD, regrouped to save ground and staked the pace, came off the inside leaving the far turn, pursued three wide into the stretch and faded. TALK SHOW MAN, bumped around the first turn, recovered and stalked four wide, came under pressure into the far turn but lacked a solid response. FRAN'S BUCKAROO was steadied into the first turn, lost ground five wide around the far turn, made a mild run then flattened out. TITAN ALEXANDER saved ground prompting the winner, failed to go on leaving the three eighths pole and gave way. FRED HIGH, wide into the backstretch, failed to menace. FORT COLLINS, washy pre race, hesitated at the break and was outrun. NOT ABROAD, bumped while between rivals mid way on the first turn, continued between foes to stalk the pace then faltered around the final turn.
