ONE GO ALL GO came in leaving the starting gate, assumed the early lead, saved ground setting the pace, was set down turning for home, switched to his right led late and dug in tenaciously under energetic urging. FUNDAMENTAL, angled in soon after the break, was inside horses entering the far turn, swung to the four path turning for home, brushed with GREAT DANCER in upper stretch, closed gamely between horses and was bumped by FORCE THE PASS in deep stretch. FORCE THE PASS, bumped on both sides leaving the starting gate, moved up three deep the far turn, lacked the needed rally and bumped FUNDAMENTAL when drifting out late. GREAT DANCER (IRE) saved ground around the first turn, was between horses the far turn, floated to the four path leaving the turn, brushed with FUNDAMENTAL in upper stretch and closed the gap late. GO AROUND, outside the winner, chased that one to mid stretch then gave way. GALLERY saved ground in a forward position and gave way. MAJESTIC PRIDE lacked speed, lost ground the first turn, was five deep the far turn and was never a factor.
