TROUBLE KID crowded rivals while guided inward between the five eighths pole to the four and a half furlong marker, secured the rail when clearing a half mile out, set the pace under rating, came under a ride soon into the lane, kept on under repeated right handed rousing the final furlong and held firm. GENTLEMEN'S BET raced with the early pace three wide between rivals, was snatched back and bumped with PALACE when put in tight by TROUBLE KID leaving the five eighths, regrouped to make a quick three wide move leaving the three eighths pole, took closer order into the lane and continued on gamely to steadily close the gap. PALACE exchanged bumps with both GENTLEMEN'S BET and STALLWALKIN' DUDE from the five furlong marker to the four and half pole, steadied briefly then angled out, gave chase three wide into the lane and kept on willingly. STALLWALKIN' DUDE reared in the gate pre race and unseated his rider, disputed the early pace inside a trio of rivals, bumped repeatedly with PALACE after that one was tightened by the winner, swung out four wide leaving the five sixteenths and slowly gained. SONNY INSPIRED , three wide early, failed to menace. SIR ROCKPORT was steadied soon after the break, made a four wide mid move and faded. SPRING TO THE SKY failed to keep pace. CUTTY SHARK saved ground and weakened. Following a stewards' inquiry and objection by the rider of GENTLEMEN'S BET, TROUBLE KID was disqualified from first and placed second for causing interference in the backstretch run
