PHLASH PHELPS stalked the pace two to three wide, briefly steadied when caught in a bit close approaching the head of the stretch, regrouped and responded when shoved on, surged between rivals in mid stretch, spurted clear inside the sixteenth marker then held firm while under steady hand encouragement. EYEPLAYEVERYDAY settled off the rail, commenced a run leaving the three eighths pole, swung out six wide nearing the top of the lane, straightened away and finished with good energy. ROADHOG stalked the pace three to four wide, moved to challenge approaching the quarter pole, forged to command leaving the three sixteenths, could not fend off the winner departing the furlong grounds then gave way late. TALK SHOW MAN settled back off the pace while saving ground, swung out in upper stretch then found his best stride too late. GRANDIFLORA saved ground within range, crept closer leaving the far turn, slipped through a rail opening nearing the stretch and took command, was soon joined from ROADHOG, dueled to mid stretch then weakened late. LOVE'S NOT FAIR steadied when in close after the break, raced removed from the rail, progressed a bit in upper stretch then flattened out. HE'S ACHANCE broke slowly, recovered and tugged his way forward off the rail, moved menacingly leaving the five sixteenths, swung five wide soon after, straightened away, failed to seriously kick on and faded in the final furlong. CAPITAL FELLOW cleared early, set the pace towards the inside, wandered out some nearing the quarter pole giving GRANDIFLORA a path, stayed on to the three sixteenths then succumbed. CONNEMARA COAST was sent up between rivals leaving the five eighths pole, angled in to give hard chase past the three eighths then tired. HIRAM saved ground early and retreated.
