Footnotes

FORMAL SUMMATION attended the pace three deep under some rating, spurted away when asked past the five sixteenths, opened up a large advantage nearing the eighth pole then held sway under a drive. CAPTAIN ALEX settled off the pace while two wide, angled five wide nearing the lane, closed willingly while drifting in and outfinished THUNDER PASS for the place. THUNDER PASS, fractious in the gate, broke a step slow, was guided towards the rail entering the turn, moved up past the five sixteenths, angled four wide into the lane, gained ground nearing the sixteenth pole, drifted in and flattened out late. RANGER'S COMING chased the pace, moved up four wide into the lane, drifted in leaving the three sixteenths pole and came up empty. MID LIFE CRISIS was sent up towards the inside of a pair of rivals early, battled under a hustling ride to mid turn then gave way. SPLIT, off the pace, angled five wide for the drive but lacked a rally. LOUISE THE LASER broke sharply and led early, dueled between rivals heading into the turn, could not keep pace with the winner entering the lane and gave way. GOTTA BE GOLD dropped back under a ride in the opening furlong, found himself well off the pace mid turn, angled wide and failed to recover.
