AWAY WE GO broke well, tracked the pace three wide, shifted out wider past the three sixteenths, made a grinding run under solid right hand rousing, overtook the dueling leaders in deep stretch then prevailed between rivals. CRYPTOS' HOLIDAY, taken to rate off the rail, edged closer between rivals nearing the stretch, swung well out into the course for the final sixteenth, closed gamely and was getting to the winner. CHEROKEE COUSIN, well placed in the clear, moved up behind the dueling leaders in mid stretch, steadied lacking room, altered out late and finished well between runners. HOLIDAY WISHES was hustled clear early, set the pace towards the inside, was engaged by NEW TURF in upper stretch, dueled inside that one past the eighth pole,

drifted out a bit, corrected and stayed on well. NEW TURF leaned in and hit the gate to be away slowly, recovered and showed a nice turn of foot to move to contention into the turn, bid three wide in upper stretch, dueled under solid pressure past the furlong grounds and kept on willingly. GEM saved ground under rating while not far back, eased out a bit to advance past mid stretch but lacked a solid kick in the final seventy yards. FRANKIN STORM, four wide chasing the pace, faded. STREET MIZ, taken to rate off the pace, angled in around the turn, made a mild run in mid stretch then flattened out. GRACE IS READY, under a snug hold four to five wide off the early pace, dropped in a few paths mid turn while put to pressure then lacked a stretch rally. FREE UNION, unruly behind the gate, broke slowly, was steadied soon after, saved ground mid turn and failed to menace. MANAKIN ROAD failed to menace. OCCASIONALLY broke through the gate pre race, steadied early and failed to pose a threat.
