

LOOK WHO'S TALKING broke alertly but a bit to the outside, was quickly righted and was patiently handled three deep allowing a pair of rivals to go and battle for command, applied more pressure after a half mile, asserted herself when asked mid turn, opened up leaving the three sixteenths then held sway while under left handed encouragement through the final furlong. LEXINGTON STREET settled in range while four wide, edged closer nearing the half mile pole, came under pressure three furlongs out but failed to initially quicken with the winner heading towards the quarter pole, leveled off departing the furlong grounds and finished nicely to close the gap. JUMP FOR LOVE stalked the pace three wide between rivals, shifted out five wide nearing the lane, straightened away and kept on willingly to nab the show. IF I WAS A BOY took over between rivals nearing the three quarter pole, was hounded from both sides, ceded command to the winner leaving the five sixteenths, dropped to the rail and gave way grudgingly. FRIESAN FLYER hopped at the break and was away last, angled in some advancing past the five eighths, was under pressure between rivals mid turn, failed to go on and dropped back. EVE bobbled at the break, saved ground off the pace, angled out for the drive and failed to menace. PRINCESS TALIA was hustled up inside rivals to join the pace fray, was pushed along vying into the turn, could not match strides leaving the three eighths and faltered.
