RAVENHEART broke a step slow, recovered then tugged his way forward while between rivals, tracked three wide around the turn, bumped with SHOWALTER when that one drifted out soon into the lane, regrouped and forged clear under left handed rousing in mid stretch, wandered outward when meeting the challenge of FLASH MCCAUL inside the sixteenth marker, failed to switch leads but dug in tenaciously to prevail. FLASH MCCAUL, taken to rate off the early pace, edged up inside rivals nearing the half mile marker, angled out and was put to a ride mid turn, came five wide for the drive, ranged up outside to engage the winner in with about seventy yards to go, battled gamely while floated out late and just missed. IT'S THE JOURNEY drafted back between rivals early, dropped in to save ground mid turn, shifted out leaving the three sixteenths, advanced between rivals and kept on willingly to outfinish CAPTAIN ALEX for the show. CAPTAIN ALEX, four wide, moved closer into the far turn, was under a strong ride chasing past the five sixteenths, was fanned six wide into the lane, straightened and finished with interest. EASY RIVER stalked the pace while saving ground, eased out near mid stretch but came up empty. CORVUS took command leaving the chute, set the pace towards the rail, was hounded by SHOWALTER around the turn, remained in front into the lane, ceded to the winner inside the three sixteenths and weakened late. KING OF VERSAILLES, towards the inside, failed to menace. WELCOME FAIRBANKS, three wide between rivals chasing the pace, gave way. SHOWALTER stumbled at the break, recovered and prompted the pace outside of CORVUS, was put to heavy pressure past the five sixteenth, bobbed after drifting out and bumping the winner in upper stretch, failed to kick on and retreated through the final furlong.
