**Footnotes**

INTERRUPTED rated close up while saving ground, came under pressure advancing into the lane, altered out for a clear run leaving the three sixteenths, drifted well out into the course while under left handed rousing, rallied past the dueling leaders inside the sixteenth marker then edged clear late. SPEED SEEKER broke a step slow, pulled her way clear while about four wide passing the wire the first time, dropped in to set a rated pace, met an outside challenge from PINK POPPY entering the stretch, maintained a tenuous advantage dueling past the furlong grounds, kept on gamely once overtaken and gamely saved the place. PINK POPPY prompted the pace two wide, moved when asked past the five sixteenths and took on the leader, entered the stretch three wide, dueled past the sixteenth marker and hung late. FASNACLOICH settled off the pace while saving some ground, crept closer into the far turn, angled four wide approaching the stretch but failed to muster up a significant response. MONSTER SLEEPING stalked the pace three wide, came under pressure after six furlongs, remained prominent to upper stretch then faded. JOY , in range three wide, brushed with SUMBA SUNSET down the backstretch, made a mild four wide run near the quarter pole, failed to kick on leaving eighth pole and faded. SUMBA SUNSET was taken four wide in the opening furlong, remained well out in the course from there, brushed with JOY near the half mile pole and gave way. RED HOT TWEET , between horses tracking the early pace, remained a factor to the far turn then dropped back.
