LEXINGTON STREET broke inward, was corrected and hustled up between rivals to reach contention, tracked the dueling leaders around the turn, angled four wide while under continued urging past the five sixteenths, forged to command heading towards the eighth pole, drifted in under right handed rousing while clear then continued to widen despite switching to her left lead. FLY GIRL set a pressured pace inside, dueled with TABLE JUMPER from the quarter pole past the three sixteenths, kept on gamely and narrowly held down the place. TABLE JUMPER prompted the pace outside FLY GIRL, moved to near even terms after a half mile, battled past the three sixteenths then stayed willingly to the wire. JUMP FOR LOVE, off the pace, was ridden along three wide mid turn, angled out in the drive and had some belated action. SHE ROLLS bobbled at the break, regrouped and hustled up four wide to a stalking spot, came under pressure mid turn then faded in the final furlong. HEAD GAMES saved ground in range into the turn, was scrubbed along mid turn and came up empty. MARYLAND'S LOVE, away alertly, stalked three wide between rivals, was lightly shuffled leaving the far turn, angled four to five wide into the lane but went even from there. CLARE'S DOWERY leaned in at the break and was off a bit slowly, raced four to five wide into the lane but failed to menace. ADDED SPICE was rated back between runners leaving the five eighths pole, came under pressure mid turn and failed to threaten.
