## Footnotes

SPRING TO THE SKY sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace near the rail, dug in tenaciously and prevailed under a drive. NIGHT OFFICER, three wide on the turn, took aim on the leader in upper stretch, remained on his left lead and flattened out. A P ELVIS lacked speed off the rail on the turn, was taken to the five path in upper stretch and rallied outside foes. OAK BLUFFS, well place four deep in upper stretch, failed to rally. BLAMESHIFTER lacked speed, was taken very wide for the stretch run and passed tired horses. JACK'S IN THE DECK, two wide between horses leaving the turn, failed to rally in an even effort. ANCIL raced in the two path on the turn and was not a factor. BARNEY REBEL (IRE), along the rail on the turn, was outrun. AGAINST THE WIN chased the pace two wide on the turn and dropped back through the stretch. RAPID DAN, sent down the backstretch, hugged the rail, chased the pace and steadled in close quarters in upper stretch.
