This means if you win one of the stake races, and are Maryland Million eligible you will be racing on Maryland Million Day in 2015 you will automatically get in a race and you do not have to pay your pre-entry, entry or run fees. Nominations closed Thursday August 13, 2015 with 13 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race on the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five and One half Furlongs). (S)

**Footnotes**

BEN'S CAT , confidently rated in the four path behind horses around the turn, eased out to the six path in upper stretch, closed outside horses, drifted in a bit under right hand whipping in mid stretch, straightened when the rider switched the whip to his left hand while taking the lead near the sixteenth pole and was best under steady handling late. NIGHT OFFICER , three wide between horses dueling for the lead on the turn, asserted himself in upper stretch then dug in late inside the winner to prove best of the others. SONNY INSPIRED dueled inside horses around the turn and faded the final furlong. JACK'S IN THE DECK circled the turn five deep and failed to rally. WIRE FUNDS rushed up in four path to gain the lead entering the turn, dueled to upper stretch then weakened. DISCO ELVIS showed early speed between horses, was rated back leaving the backstretch, swung to the five path leaving the turn and was not a factor. MAGNIFICENT MR Z , lightly steadied in close quarters along the rail entering the turn, retreated through the stretch.
