PAGE MCKENNEY broke well and showed early speed along the rail, dropped back under patient handling leaving the first turn, advanced inside horses entering the far turn, swung to the three path mid way on the bend, was set down turning for home, secured command approaching the eighth under brisk urging then drew away. GOLDEN GLINT circled the first turn four deep, was forwardly placed down the backstretch, advanced in the two path on the far turn to reach a striking position, was no match for the winner through the stretch and rallied outside WARRIOROF THEROSES to gain the place. WARRIOROF THEROSES, clear on the first turn, set the pace along the rail, finished willingly but faded late. CATRON, three wide the first turn, raced in the two path on the far turn, was floated to the three path turning for home, drifted in near the three sixteenths pole and failed to be a threat. MONKEY'S MEDAL, checked in tight quarters mid way on the first turn, was not a factor. BELLARMINE came out on MONKEY'S MEDAL mid way on the first turn, chased the pace, saved ground on the far turn, faltered in upper stretch and drifted out late.
