

EXAGGERATED pulled her way clear after about a furlong, set a rated pace towards the inside, responded when shaken up in upper stretch, eagerly spurted away heading towards the furlong pole, was roused once right handed near the sixteenth marker and proved much the best while being kept alert. AWAKE THE DAY came out a bit early then was corrected, rated between runners while in range, angled four wide into the lane, moved up in mid stretch and gave game chase to the wire. OLGA PAYNE steadied when put in tight in the early stages, recovered and rated between foes, commenced a run mid turn, progressed between horses in upper stretch and kept on with interest. TRISH'S WISH saved ground chasing the pace and came up empty late. WHENNOONE'SLOOKING was floated out early by AWAKE THE DAY, straightened and moved up three wide into the turn, stalked into the lane, gave chase past the eighth pole then faded late. HOOLIGAN, off the early pace, eased back between foes entering the turn, circled four wide under a hustling ride, angled out wider in upper stretch and offered a belated kick. NANCY'S GONE WILD saved ground off the pace, angled out in upper stretch but failed to pose a threat. ROXBURY ROCKET, four wide chasing the pace, remained a presence to the five sixteenths then faded. GRATZIE stalked the pace two wide, failed to go on entering the lane then retreated between foes. PERFECT TRACE was checked when put in close early, angled in and had no recovery.
