TWO NOTCH ROAD , patiently rated in the two path between horses on the turn, eased out to the four path in upper stretch, advanced outside horses under confident handling, took command near the sixteenth pole and edged clear with something in reserve. MADE BAIL , in the two path turning for home, gained a brief lead between horses near the eighth pole, drifted out late, was no match for the winner and received a tap on the neck by her rider when galloping out. SIMMSTOWN lacked speed, saved ground around the turn, altered course to the three path near the eighth pole and rallied mildly. CAP'N RAYMOND , steadied in close quarters along the rail leaving the backstretch, eased out to the two path turning for home, raced between horses in the stretch and passed tired ones. MOUNT RECOVERY circled the turn three deep and failed to rally. SERVICE FOR TEN , outrun, raced well off the rail on the turn, swung outside in mid stretch and lacked a response. RUNNINGINTHEVALE , three deep on the turn, chased the pace, lugged in near the eighth pole and gave way. JAKE RATTLE N ROLL , wide on the turn, was outrun. PRIDE OF THE FLEET , rushed to the early lead, set the pace along the rail and faltered near the eighth pole.
