JACK'S IN THE DECK rated three wide just off the lead, dropped in a path and engaged SHIRAKUMA mid turn, poked a head in front after a half mile, briefly went clear in upper stretch, met BEN'S CAT bid nearing the eighth pole, dueled under left handed rousing, wandered outward late and dug in tenaciously to narrowly prevail. BEN'S CAT rated close up while saving ground, angled three wide nearing the quarter pole, ranged up to engage the winner in mid stretch, dueled, was floated out late and hung. D C DANCER settled off the rail, gathered momentum when asked mid turn, angled four wide into the lane, cut into the margin in mid stretch then flattened out. COACH FRIDGE rated off the pace two wide, raced between rivals near the quarter pole, angled out in the drive and rallied. IT'S A BANG pressed the pace two wide and faded mid turn. REGAL SOLDIER, four wide most of the trip, failed to menace. SHIRAKUMA set a pressured pace towards the rail, ceded command after a half and weakened. TRICKY LION, rank at the break, was hustled up inside nearing the half mile pole, stumbled when in tight near the quarter pole and unseated his rider. There was a stewards' inquiry concerning TRICKY LION but no action was deemed necessary
