

CODE OF CONDUCT

Every guest who visits Maryland Jockey Club properties deserves the best possible experience. You can contribute to a great experience by always conducting yourself appropriately and making sure that anyone you invite does the same.

FOR THE ENJOYMENT AND SAFETY OF ALL, THE FOLLOWING BEHAVIORS ARE PROHIBITED:

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive, or illegal in nature
- Intoxication or other signs of alcohol or substance impairment that result in irresponsible behavior
- Interference with the progress of the event (including throwing objects onto the track)
- Entering any restricted areas
- Failing to follow instructions of law enforcement, guest experience, and security personnel
- Verbal or physical harassment
- Unreasonably obstructing the view of others
- Offensive language or obscene gestures, including the use of such language or gestures concerning a person's race, ethnicity, color, sexual orientation, gender, religion, creed, disability, age, incite or encourage a confrontation or physical assault
- Signs/Banners of an inappropriate nature
- Political attire

FIREARM POLICY

Firearms are not permitted on property with the exclusion of working law enforcement personnel or working protective service guards.

Security staff who encounter an individual with a firearm during the security search will alert the individual of the policy while the security supervisor will alert law enforcement at the entry point.
